Ladies and Gentlemen I share with immense pleasure that **in** the Education World's Indian school Rankings 2019, Neerja Modi School is ranked as the Number 1 Day cum Boarding school of Rajasthan. Also I am happy to let you know that **in** the Swacchhta Survey 2019 Neerja Modi School has been ranked No. 1 in Jaipur in the **SCHOOLS** Category.

Our batch of 2018-19 has made us proud with their fabulous CBSE Board results.

In the CBSE grade XII examination held in March 2019 Navya Bhandari from the commerce stream with an aggregate of 98.4% was the city topper. 76 Students scored overall 90% and above and 204 students had overall distinction. 43 students scored a perfect 100 in various subjects.

The CBSE class X 2019 result was fabulous too. Rupal Garg with 98.6% was the top scorer. 17 students scored an

aggregate of 97% and above, 54 students scored an aggregate of 95% and above and 122 students scored an aggregate 90% & above. 34 students scored a perfect 100 in various subjects.

The batch of 2019 also earned some fantastic University placements across the world. Yashovardhan Raniwala is at UC Berkley, Sanchit Agarwal is at UCLA, Mehul Agarwal is at Johns Hopkins. It is indeed heartwarming to see NMS students all over the world and that overall our students have bagged almost 30 crores as scholarship amount.

We are also proud of our students who have made it to the top institutions of the country. 5 of our students have made it to the prestigious IITs. Aryan Jain secured an AIR 76 and is at IIT Delhi, Kshitij Singhal is at IIT Guwahati, both Meghna Kataria and Sanaa Sharma are at IIT Mumbai and Piyush Agarwal is at IIT, Kanpur. 5 students Sahil Gangawani, Prakhar Gupta, Abhirath Joshi, Chimany Goel and Arihant Jain have made it to the various BITS Campuses, 4 students Aditya Sharma, Stuti Arora, Saurabh Tanvar and Lochan Bagri have qualified the NEET Medical examination to join reputed Medical colleges in the country. Quite a few students have joined colleges of their choice in Delhi &

Mumbai University. Apoorv Nigam is at SRCC, Mahima Singh is at LSR, Jhanak Sethia is at Miranda House. 4 students have joined NMIMS Mumbai while 5 students have joined Jai Hind College Mumbai University to name a few. Titiksha Gupta is at Azim Premji University and Rishabh Singh Jain is attending Ashoka University. 2 students Navya Bhandari & Rishabh Periwal have joined the National Law University. Navya Bhandari is a proud recipient of prestigious and highly competitive Aditya Birla Scholarship. Aryan Jain with an all India rank 83 received the KVPY fellowship offered by the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India. Abhinav Ghunawat, Aditya Gupta and Dhruv Agarwal have been awarded the NTSE Scholarship by the NCERT for pursuing courses in medicine, engineering, science or social science up to doctoral level. Each year an ever rising number of our students excel in various Olympiad examinations at national and International level. This year 7 students won the Gold medal in National Cyber Olympiad, 11 students won the gold medal in National Science Olympiad, another 19 students won the gold medal in International Mathematics Olympiad, 11 students won the Gold Medal in International Olympiad of mathematics,6

students bagged the Gold in NSTSE to mention a few of the exhaustive list.

Two of our teams have also qualified for the Nationals of Make X, a prestigious Robotics competition. They are the only two teams selected from Rajasthan. We wish them good luck for their upcoming finals in November.

Another area in which we have made ripples again this year, is the sports and games. Our students have done extremely well in football, basketball, Cricket, swimming, skating, Archery, rifle shooting, chess, badminton, Squash, table tennis and Lawn tennis and have made us proud. NMS students of the middle and Senior School have made place in the National U-14 and U-17 Basketball teams. In Tennis, Sachi Sharma with 8 consecutive victories is ranked in the top 50 Tennis Players of India by All India Tennis Association. We are also proud of Vihan Khandelwal and Vanya Bohra who have won Skating tournaments at national level. The NMS U 14 Football team is the proud Runner up of the prestigious Subroto Mukherjee Football Cup 2019. Sarthak Bhargava has Qualified to play National Squash Tournament this year. 2 students Adya Sinha and Anya Sinha have been selected for the SGFI under 14 National Table Tennis tournament. The Rajasthan Table Tennis

Association has ranked Vikram Nahata as State's No 3 Player. He is also selected for Nationals.

Kaavya Jain bagged 3 Bronze medals for her performance in the SGFI U 17 Archery tournament.

Shivika Sarawgi is selected for U 11 Chess Nationals.

Anshul winning 2 gold medals at State Shooting Championship is selected for the National shooting Championship 2019.

Tanya Agarwal of grade X has won many accolades in Cyclothons and Marathons. We are proud of all our Sports achievers.

Our students have achieved fantastic accolades in various co curricular fields as well. The NMS Dance team won the First Runner up Trophy in the State Level D-Fest Dance Competition 2019.

The INTACH movie filmed by our Grade 9 and 10 students won the Best Film Award in the Jaipur Children's Film Festival and is selected for screening at the International Children's Film Festival to be held at Hyderabad this December.

Teacher training and student leadership development continue to be our priority. The school is leaving no stone unturned in equipping both the teacher and the taught.

The Jaipur Debate 2019 hosted by Neerja Modi School saw phenomenal participation by the best Debating teams from leading schools of the country including the Dhirubhai Ambani International School, Mumbai, The Vasant Valley School, Pathways World School, Mothers International School and Blue Bells School from New Delhi, CHIREC International School, Hyderabad, Bishop Cotton School, Shimla to name a few. This year's Trophy was lifted by Vasant Valley School, New Delhi.

Other student driven programmes such as the MUN, Tedx Kids & Youth, Young Students Praliament, Inter School Cultural & Sports Meets, Collection Drives and Community Service Programmes are becoming bigger by the day due to active participation and meticulous planning and implementation by the student council, class monitors and ever enthusiastic volunteers.
